


## Spelling/Word Study Homework

Students, each week you will receive new spelling/word study words. Words will be written in the student agenda. You will choose from the following options to complete spelling/word study homework for the week. You are required to complete **four (4) assignments** from the menu below. Homework needs to be completed in the **Spelling Notebook** and returned by **Friday** of each week.



<p><b>Pyramids</b> Write your words like this:</p> 	<p><b>Rainbow Words x3</b> Write your words 3 times each using at least 3 different colors. (Layer the colors on top of each other to create "rainbow words")</p>	<p><b>Word Sort x2</b> Sort and write your words in a chart according to the phonics pattern. Write the chart <b><u>2 times</u></b>.</p>
<p><b>Wordle</b> Use the following website to create a design with your words, then cut and paste your creation in your notebook. <a href="http://www.wordle.net/create">http://www.wordle.net/create</a></p>	<p><b>Ransom Words</b> Use magazines or newspapers to find your spelling words. Cut and glue them in your notebook.</p>	<p><b>Sentences</b> Write a meaningful sentence for each of your spelling words. Vary your sentences to include <b><u>commands, statements, questions, and exclamations.</u></b></p>
<p><b>ABC order x2</b> Write your spelling words in alphabetical order. Write the list <b><u>2 times</u></b>.</p>	<p><b>Story/Poem</b> Write a story or poem using your words. Be sure to underline each of your words.</p>	<p><b>Practice Spelling Test</b> Have someone give you a practice test. If the test is oral, have someone initial your notebook. Write down any words you missed.</p>
