Please mark your calendars! The 3rd grade will present a Living History Wax Museum the evening of Thursday, April 27, 2017. Students will need to arrive to the cafeteria by 5:00 PM to set up their areas.

We are asking that each student bring in a **plain tri-fold science fair board** to be used as the background during the presentations. (The boards will be decorated at school). **Please send in a plain tri-fold science fair board as soon as possible, but no later than March 21st.**

Key Information:

- Each student will research the biography of a famous person that has made positive contributions to our world.
- Most of this project will be completed at school. (We will ask for you to help your child memorize their speech and come up with a costume, but all of the research and writing will take place at school).
- Students will recite a ~1 minute narrative about this person. The speech will be written in first person. They will need to memorize this speech.
- Students will create a background for their museum space. (This will be done at school).
- Finally, students will put together a costume that resembles their famous person. (We will need your help with this - Try to use what you have at home - don't feel like you need to buy anything special!)
